The classification and labeling of chemicals is changing.

DiaSorin is pleased to inform you that labeling, the Safety Data Sheets, the Safety Sheet Notes and the Instructions For Use of all the products are under revision in terms of safety symbols and statements.

The Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 on the classification, labeling and packaging of substances and mixtures is hereafter referred to as CLP. The Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals is called REACH.

The CLP Regulation amends the Dangerous Substance Directive 67/548/EEC (DSD), the Dangerous Preparations Directive 1999/45/EC (DPD).

Directive 67/548/EEC and Directive 1999/45/EC shall be repealed with effect from 1 June 2015 (CLP Article 60). The CLP is based on the 3rd revision of the United Nations' Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (UN GHS) and is implementing the provisions of the GHS within the EU, without lowering the protection of human health and the environment, compared to the classification, labeling and packaging system in DSD and DPD. The CLP and GHS main objectives are to facilitate international trade in chemicals and to maintain the existing level of protection of human health and environment. The GHS is a United Nations system to identify hazardous chemicals and to inform users about these hazards through standard symbols and phrases on the packaging labels and through safety data sheets (SDS). **For further information you can visit <http://echa.europa.eu/regulations> and http://www.unece.org/trans/danger/publi/ghs/ghs_welcome_e.html.**

Because there is such a lengthy transition period for mixtures (until June 1, 2015 in Europe), DiaSorin is progressively transitioning its labeling to the GHS system in conjunction with other technical updates. DiaSorin is planning to transition all of our products to GHS by June 1, 2015. In the transition period you may receive products still labeled according to old Directives and products already labeled according to the GHS system.
